The 2019 Jacks Are Wild is sophisticated elegance, with surprisingly varied aromatics intertwined seamlessly. Rich aromatics of plum, and chocolate lead into intriguing aromas of thyme, oregano, soil and bay leaf. The palate entices with a depth of dark fruits, blackberry, black currant, and black cherry, interwoven with delicate notes of quince and fig. The ripe fruit is supported with clove, vanilla, black pepper, and smokey bacon. Each sip finishes with a delicate swath of velvet tannins, showing restraint and elegance. In order to experience the true bold elegance of this wine, decant for 35-45 minutes before enjoying. Drink now through 2026.
